**THE ASSAM DISPLACED PERSONS (REHABILITATION LOANS)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1957**

further to amend the Assam Displaced Persons (Rehabilitation Loans) Act, 1951.

Preamble.—Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Displaced Persons (Rehabilitation Loans) Act, 1951 (Assam Act XVI of 1951), hereinafter called the Principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing :

It is hereby enacted in the Eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Assam Displaced Persons (Rehabilitation Loans) (Amendment) Act, 1957.

(2) It shall have the like extent as the Principal Act.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 2 of Assam Act XVI of 1951.—

(1) For Sub-clause (i) of Clause (c) of Section 2 of the Principal Act, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(i) a person who on account of the partition of India or on account of civil disturbances or the fear of such disturbances in any area now forming part of India or Pakistan has been displaced from or compelled to leave his place of residence in such area on or after the prescribed date and who has subsequently been residing in India, and is in distress ;”

(2) For Clause (i) of Section 2 of the Principal Act, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(i) Prescribed date—

(1) in relation to a person displaced from or compelled to leave his place of residence in the District of Noakhali or the district of Commilla now forming part of East Pakistan, means the first day of October, 1946.

(2) in relation to a person displaced from or compelled to leave his place of residence in any other area now forming part of East Pakistan, means the first day of June, 1947.

(3) in relation to a person displaced from or compelled to leave his place of residence in any area now forming part of Pakistan other than East Pakistan, means the first day of March, 1947.

(4) in relation to a person displaced from or compelled to leave his place of residence in any area now forming part of India, means the first day of January, 1950”.
