THE ASSAM GENERAL CLAUSES (AMENDMENT)  
ACT, 1988.

An

Act

to amend the Assam General Clauses Act, 1915.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam General Clauses Act, 1915, hereinafter called the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Assam Act  
II of 1915.

It is hereby enacted in the Thirtyninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam General Clauses (Amendment) Act, 1988.

Insertion of  
new Section  
25-A.

2. In the principal Act, after section 25, the following new section "25-A" shall be inserted, namely:—

"25-A. (1) All rules made by the State Government under an Assam Act shall, as soon as may be after they are made, be laid before the State Legislature, while it is in session, for a total period of not less than fourteen days which may be comprised in one session or two or more successive sessions, and shall, unless some later date is appointed, take effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette subject to such modifications or annulments as the Legislature may, during the said period agree to make, so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done thereunder.

(2) Where any Central Act, in force or applicable to the State of Assam and relating to matters with respect to which the State Legislature has power to make laws for the State of Assam, confers power on the State Government to make rules thereunder, then subject to any express provisions to the contrary in such Act, the provisions of sub-section (1) shall mutatis mutandis inply to the rules made by the State Government in exercise of that power".
