3. The Report is based on the information and materials furnished by the Social Welfare Department, Government of Assam.
4. The Committee held its first sitting on 7th September, 2021 with Social Welfare Department.
5. The Committee considered and adopted the draft report in its sitting held on ~~04-03-22~~.
6. The Committee wishes to express their thanks to the Departmental officials of the Social Welfare Department, for appearing before the Committee and furnishing requisite documents/papers etc.

REPORT

Chapter-1

The committee on welfare of Women and Children of the fifteenth Assam Legislative Assembly held its first sitting with the Social Welfare Department, Government of Assam on 7th September, 2021 to examine the Action Taken report on the recommendations made in the Seventh Report of the committee which was presented to the House on 24th March, 2020 and to discuss various schemes/ project for welfare of Women and Children implemented by the Social Welfare Department in the state of Assam, as per provisions of the functions of the committee enunciated in the rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Assam Legislative Assembly.

During the course of discussion, the departmental representatives after taking oath tendered their evidences before the Committee. The Committee examined the Action Taken Report as well as the documents/papers and carefully considered the submission of the concerned department. The Department also furnished a note in the following schemes/projects for the Welfare of Women and Children implemented by them as stated under:

1. **Supplementary Nutrition Programme:-** Supplementary Nutrition Programme is aimed at improving health and nutritional status of children of the age group of 6 months to 3 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers for providing Take Home Ration. Similarly, Hot Cook Meal is provided to the children of the age group of children 3-6 years who attends AWCs regularly. Double ration is provided to the severely malnourished children.
2. **Integrated Child Development Services(ICDS) Scheme:-** The Scheme is targeted at children up to the age of 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers like providing Pre- School education, Immunization, Health check-up, Referral Services. Now ICDS Scheme has been implemented covering all Blocks in the State through the Anganawadi Centres (AWC).
3. **Scheme for Adolescent Girls(SAG):-** The objective of this scheme is to improve the nutrition and health status of girls in the age – group of 11 to 14 years (Out of School). Under Non-Nutrition component, skill development is provided.
4. **Integrated Child Protection Scheme:-** ICPS is a centrally Sponsored Scheme of Government of India, started in the year 2009. ICPS aims at building a protective environment for all children with a special focus on most vulnerable, i.e. Children in Conflict with law, children in need of care & protection. In Assam the scheme started implementing from the year 2010.

5. **Poshan Abhiyaan:-** Poshan Abhiyaan is central Govt. flagship programme. The objective of Poshan Abhiyaan is to reduce stunting, under-nutrition, anaemia (among young children, adolescent girls and women) and reduce low birth weights across all the districts of the State.
6. **Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana:-** Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) is a maternity benefit program run by the Government of India. It is implemented by the Ministry of Women and Children Development. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for Pregnant Women and Lactating Mother (PW & LM) for first live birth only.
7. **Mahila Shakti Kendra Scheme:-** "Mahila Shakti Kendra Scheme" was announced at 2017-18 budget speech to provide "one stop convergent support services for empowering rural women with opportunities for skill development, employment, digital literacy, health, nutrition etc. The objective of this scheme is to provide interface for rural women to avail government entitlements through awareness generation and training & capacity building. State Project Management Unit- for MSK and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme is State Resource Centre for women (SRCW) established and functional under Nodal Officer, SRCW/MSK appointed by Govt. of Assam. 27 districts were sanctioned in two phases and 18 districts are now functional in Assam. State Task Force is the empowering body at state level for implementation of MSK and the District Level Task Force is the empowered body at district level to recruit and functional of DLCW and also for Block Level MSK.
8. **Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme:-** The Scheme Launched in 2014-15 and was expanded in 2015-16. Fund received by BBBP Kamrup metro district of Assam in 2016-17 for the first time and the activities started. Govt. of India releases fund to the District Administration directly for implementation of BBBP Scheme which is a multisectoral scheme of Social Welfare (Nodal), Health and Education Department. The Goal of the scheme is to celebrate the Girl Child and enable her education. Specific objectives are to prevent Gender based sex selective elimination, to ensure survival and protection of Girl Child and to ensure education and participation of girl child. The scheme is to sensitise the population like frontline workers, pregnant and lactating mothers, adolescent group, newly married couple, in-laws, Doctors and laboratory technicians, Teachers etc.

9. **Bharosa:-** Scheme to prevent and protect women from Trafficking and Witch Hunting. The scheme will focus on mass awareness on trafficking and Witch hunting, its causes and consequences in order to assure women of safety and dignity by adopting precautionary measures.
10. **Swadhar Greh:-** Scheme for women in difficult circumstances was launched by the Department of Women & Child Development in 2001-2002. The objectives of this scheme are : 1. to prevent women from exploitation and to support their survival and rehabilitation, the scheme of Short Stay Home for women and girls was introduced as a social defence mechanism by the department of Social Welfare. 2. The scheme is meant to provide temporary accommodation, maintenance and rehabilitative service to women and girls rendered homeless due to family discord, crime, violence, mental stress, social ostracism. 3. There are all together 17 nos of Swadhar Greh at different districts of Assam. Which are as follows: Karimganj, Hailakandi, Kamrup(M) 3 nos., Nagaon- 2 nos., Dhubri, Cachar, Golaghat, Dibrugarh, Morigaon- 2 nos., Sonitpur 2 nos., Lakhimpur – 1 and Jorhat – 1.
11. **Suraksha:-** (Scheme for prevention and protection of Women against violence) The scheme will strongly focus on creating awareness on existing provision mandate by the laws for the safeguarding of women and to curb gender based violence.
12. **Ujjawala Homes:-** The Union Ministry of Women & Child Development formulated central scheme "Ujjawala" which is a comprehensive scheme for Rehabilitation and Reintegration of trafficking victims. There are all together 19 nos. of Ujjawala in 18 districts of Assam, Which are as follows: Goalpara, Kamrup, Kamrup (M), Dhemaji, Tinsukia, Dibrugarh, Golaghat, Sonitpur, Hailakandi, Bongaigaon, Kokrajhar, Dhubri, Barpeta, Udalguri, Karimganj, Hajai, Lakhimpur, Cachar.
13. **Women Helpline "181":-** The scheme of Universalisation of Women Helpline is intended to provide 24 hours immediate and emergency response to women affected by violence through referral (Linking with appropriate authority such as police, One Stop centre, hospital) and information about women related Government schemes programmes across the country through a signal uniform number – "181". Women Helpline (WHL) is now integrated with all One Stop Centre in all 33 districts of Assam.

The Committee thoroughly discussed about the functioning and current status of the one stop centre, Women help line "181" Swadhar Greh, Ujjawala and Anganwadi center in Assam.

CHAPTER -II**Observation and Recommendations**

The Committee on Welfare of Women and Children after careful discussion on various issues related to Women and Children made the following observation and recommendations:

1. The Committee highly appreciated Mehila Shakti Kendra Scheme that was announced at 2017 -18 budget speech to provide "one stop convergent support services for empowering rural women (Social Welfare Department) The Committee also felt the need of establishing and functioning of such support services in each & every districts. So, Committee recommends and directs the Department to implement the Scheme earliest.
2. The Committee has directed the Department (Social Welfare) to consult with Deputy Commissioners about the NGOs working in women & Child Development areas .There should be proper list of NGOs with the Department & as well as with Deputy Commissioners about the NGOs (working for the Women & Children). The responsibility for the NGOs should be fixed and should be monitored constantly.
3. The Committee also discussed about Child beggars roaming around the cities. In the street of Guwahati many Children are seen engaging in begging. The Committee recommends for survey to identify basic cause of growing Child beggars . Also proper monitoring at regular intervals on such street Children by the Department.
4. The Committee appreciated the various Schemes of Department such as Supplementary Nutrition Programme, ICDS Scheme ,SAG Scheme , Integrated Child Protection Scheme, Poshan Abhiyaan, Bharosa, Swadhar Greh, Suraksha, Ujjawala Homes, and Women Helpline "181" .

Action taken Report in this regard may be submitted to the Committee within 90(ninety) days from the date of presentation the Report in the House.
