INTRODUCTION

I, Shri Promode Chandra Gogoi, Chairman, Public Accounts Committee, having been authorised to submit this report on their behalf, present the Twenty-Seventh Report of the Public Accounts Committee on the paragraph 13 at pages 17-29 of the Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India for the year 1969-70 and Appropriation Accounts, 1969-70 and Paragraph 15 at pages 18-25 of the Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India for the year 1970-71 and Appropriation Accounts, 1970-71, Paragraph 15 at pages 21-30 of the Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India for the year 1971-72 and Appropriation Accounts, 1971-72 and Paragraph 16 at pages 24-31 of the Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India for the year 1972-73 and Appropriation Accounts, 1972-73 of the Government of Assam relating to Excess over voted Grants/Charged Appropriation.

2. The Reports and Accounts were laid on the Table of the House on 4th November, 1971, 4th March, 1974, 16th September. 1974 and 5th February, 1975 respectively.

3. The Committee finalised and adopted the Report

in its sitting held on 9th November, 1977.

4. The Report and Accounts for the year 1969-70 were examined by the previous Committee the composition of which is appended to the Report as Appendix at page 10 and the Reports and Accounts for the years 1970-71, 1971-72 and 1972-73 were examined by the present Committee.

### FINANCE DEPARTMENT
