Chapter-I REPORT

POINT NO. 1: PRELIMINARY STATUS PAPER RELATING TO GRANT NO 38, TEA TRIBES & ADIVASI WELFARE

The Grant No. 38 (as per Finance (Budget) Department's Notification No.BB.13/2022/42 dated 22nd February, 2025 the Grant No in respect of Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Department has been changed to Grant No.83) of the Assam Budget relates to the Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Department and Department of Tribal Affairs (Plain). The Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Department is the Administrative Department to control the Budget for *Directorate of Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare*, Assam.

To achieve socio-economic development of the Tea Tribes community, the Govt. of Assam created a separate Directorate, viz. - Directorate for Welfare of Tea & Ex-Tea Garden Tribes, Assam under the administrative control of WPT & BC Department, in 1983-1984. In the year 2004, Govt. of Assam created a separate department namely "Tea Tribes Welfare Department (TTWD)" as Administrative Department for all-round socio-economic development of the community and proper co-ordination with other line departments in the implementation of welfare schemes. Recently, Govt. of Assam has notified a change in the name of the Department from the "Tea Tribes Welfare Department" to "Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare Department" vide Notification No. AR.08/2023/10, dtd. 13-04-2023. Accordingly, the name of the Directorate has also been changed from "Directorate of Tea Tribes Welfare, Assam" to "Directorate of Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare, Assam".

The Budget provision and expenditure for the financial years2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25 and also the Budget proposed for the financial year2025-26 under the control of the Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Deptt. is given below:

Out of the total Budget provision of Rs. 21596.15 lakhs made for the financial year 2025-26 Rs. 6410.59 lakhs and Rs.15185.56 lakhs have been earmarked under the Revenue and Capital Head respectively. It seems that for the financial year 2024-25 an amount of Rs. 8493.88 lakhs has been decreased than of the previous years Revised Budget Estimates (2024-25).

The Action Taken Report on the recommendations made in the First Report submitted by the Tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Department is appended at Annexure-I

Chapter II

OBSERVATIONS RECOMMENDATIONS ON TEA TRIBES AND ADIVASI WELFARE DEPARTMENT GRANT NO.38

The Committee after holding a threadbare discussion and on close scrutinization of the Report related to Grant No.38, Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare Department and the evidence tendered by the Departmental Representatives, made the following Observations & Recommendations.

1. The Committee observed that the Tea Tribes Community resides in small quarters offered by the Industry with the minimum amenities required to lead a livelihood.

Therefore, the Committee recommends for allotment of land to all the landless tea garden workers of the State. Moreover, the Committee also recommends for allotment of P-MAY houses to all the tea garden workers who are residing in the labour quarter / lines.

2. The Committee reiterates the recommendation under **point no. 3** of the 1st Report of DRSC (F) for the year 2024-25 and observed that more patient Guest House may be constructed.

The Committee thus recommends to expedite the construction of Patient and attendant Guest House at Guwahati. Further, the Committee recommends construction of another patient and attendant Guest House for Tea Tribes & Adivasi community at Dibrugarh, similar to the Guest House at Guwahati.

3. Out of a total of 46 boys and girls hostels, only 26 are functioning. The rest of the hostels are in an incomplete stage. Therefore, the Committee reiterates the recommendation under **point no. 4** of the 1st Report of DRSC (F) for the year 2024-25 and observed that the work may be expatiated.

As such, the Committee recommends to complete the repairing and renovation of Tea Tribes Girls Hostel at ITI, Tezpur complex and Tea Tribes Boys Hostel at Tezpur within six months of the next financial year, 2025-26.

- 4. The Committee observes that the department lacks manpower for monitoring various welfare schemes at District/Sub-Division level. Therefore, the Committee recommends to complete the proposed establishment of programme Management Unit (PMU) for monitoring of welfare schemes.
- 5. The DRSC Development (F) Committee observes that the Tea Tribes Community lack skill development in all spheres.

Therefore, the Committee recommends that special schemes may be taken up for the Skill development of Tea Tribes & Adivasi Community.

With these observations, the Committee recommends that the total amount of Rs. 21596.15 lakhs as sought for, under Grant No.38 Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare Department for the financial year, 2025-2026 be approved by the Budget Session.

The Action Taken Report on the recommendation may be submitted to the Committee within 90 days from the date of presentation of the report in the House.

The Committee also recommends to hang hoardings in from of the Labour Office, Tea Tribes areas etc.	To generate awareness among the Tea Tribes and Adivasi people about the various schemes and initiatives taken by the Govt. of Assam for the welfare of the Community, the Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare Department installed Permanent Structural Hoardings in 1100 nos. of Tea Gardens registered under ATEPFO. Further, the Department has also decided to install Permanent Structural Hoardings outside tea garden areas such as DC Office, District Hospitals (Govt.), BDO Office, Entry point to District- enroute national or state highway, Weekly Haats (Market) in Block etc. in the FY 2025-26 for publicity of welfare schemes outside Tea Gardens. In this regard, this Department has proposed Rs. 4,20,25,000.00 for installation 1581 (1100+481) nos. of hoardings for the upcoming FY 2025-26.
2	It has been noticed that due to unavailability of branch offices in District Head Quarters, people of these community have been facing various problems to communicate with the Department. So, the Committee recommends to open Branch Offices in the district Head Quarters where most of the people belonging from these community resides.	There is no any District Offices in District Headquarters under tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare Department except the office of the Director, tea Tribes & Adivasi Welfare, Assam. However, this Department has Su- Divisional Beneficiary selection Committees in respect of 41 sub- Divisions for selection of Beneficiaries for beneficiary oriented Schemes. The Sub- Divisional Welfare Officers are nominated as Member Secretary of each Committee under the Sub- Divisions.
3	The Committee strongly recommends to construct guest house for patients belonging to these communities in the places where Department feels necessary.	The Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare Department has taken up the construction of a Patients Guest House near GMCH, Guwahati with an Administrative cost of Rs. 678.71700 lakhs for the patients and the relatives of Tea Tribes and Adivasi Community. The said construction is executing by Assam State Housing Board (ASHB). The foundation stone of the said project was laid by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam on 02-03-2024.
4	The condition of Hostels of both boys and girls are very poor in Tezpur. So, the Committee recommends for taking necessary steps in this regard.
