#### **Preface**

This publication contains brief biographical sketches of the Members of the Eighth Assam Legislative Assembly elected at the 1985 General Election and the subsequent bye-elections held on 2nd March, 1986 and 23rd December, 1987. The sketches have been prepared on the basis of the information received from the Members and/or that contained in the Who's Who published in 1986. The Assembly has a strength of 126 Members. One seat had become vacant on account of the election of the Member being declared void by the Hon. Gauhati High Court. Another Member Shri Altaf Hossain Majumdar suddenly expired in New Delhi on 19.9.88. Thus in all 124 biographical sketches should have been included. But information from 2 members had not been received till the time of sending the manuscripts of the publication to the print. Their names are also given in the serial order without the biographical sketches.






