#### THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.II) ACT, 1971

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation and commencement. (No.II) Act, 1971.

- 2. The Act shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1971.

From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the of Rs.2,65, State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums 84,74,500 out of the not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Consolidated Schedule amounting in the aggregate (inclusive of Fund of the the sum specified in column 3) to the Schedule to the State of Assam Appropriation (Vote on Account Act, 1971) Assam for the financial to the sum of rupees two hundred sixty-five crores, year 1971-72.eighty-four lakhs, seventy-four thousand and five hundred towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
  - 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972.
