ASSAM ACT XV OF 1971

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.III) ACT, 1971

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 21st June 1971) [Published in the Assam Gazette, Extraordinary, dated 22nd June 1971

An Act

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1966, in excess of the amount authorised or granted for the said services.

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation Short title. (No.III) Act, 1971.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Issue of State of Assam, the sums specified in column (3) of Rs.8,32,671 the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum out of the of eight lakhs thirty-two thousand, six hundred and Consolidated seventy-one shall be deemed to have been paid and Fund of the applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the State of As-sam for the charges in respect of services specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the financial year 1965-66. thirty-first day of March, 1966, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services for

that year.

3. The sums deemed to have been paid and applied Appropriation. from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam under this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1966.
