**further to amend the Assam Legislative Assembly Members'
Salaries and Allowances Act, 1958**

Preamble. Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam ^{Assam} ^{Act}
Legislative Assembly Members' Salaries and Allow- ^{XIV} ^{of}
ances Act, 1958, hereinafter called the principal 1958.
Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-first Year of the
Republic of India as follows:—

Short title,
and
commence-
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Legis-
lative Assembly Members' Salaries and Allowances
(Amendment) Act, 1970.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. For section 6 of the principal Act, the fol-
lowing shall be substituted, namely:—

Amendment
of section 6
of Assam
Act XIV of
1958.

“6. A Member and the members of his family
shall be entitled to such medical treatment and benefits
as may be laid down by rules to be made by the
State Government.

Explanation.—1. For the purpose of this section
the expression ‘the members of his family’ shall mean
and include such members as may be prescribed by
rules.

2. Those who are entitled to free medical atten-
dance and treatment may take the same from any
registered physician of their choice—Allopathic,
Ayurvedic, Unani or Homoeopathic and medical bills
on prescription of such physicians are re-imbursable.”
