ASSAM ACT II OF 1965

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.I) ACT, 1965 [Published in the Assam Gazette Extraordinary, dated the 26th March, 1965]

An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Conso lidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1965

Short title. It is hereby enacted in the Sixteenth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.I) Act, 1965.

Withdrawal 2. From and cut of the Consolidated Fund of the of State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums from and not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the out of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Consolidated forty-two crores, sixty-five lakhs, seventy-nine thoustate of sand, six hundred and sixty-eight rupees towards Assam for defraying the several charges which will come in the financial course of payment during the year ending on the year, 1964- thirty-first day of March, 1965 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965.
