## THE ASSAM BOARD OF REVENUE ACT, 1962

#### An Act

## to provide for the constitution of a Board of Revenue for the State of Assam

Preamble

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the constitution of a Board of Revenue for the State of Assam for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing:

# CHAPTER I

# Preliminary

Short title, 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Board of extent and Revenue Act, 1962.

commen- (2) It extends to the whole of the State of cement. Assam.

(3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Definition

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context-

(1) "Board" means the Assam Board of Revenue constituted under Section 3.

(2) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act.

(3) "Schedule" means schedule to this Act.

## CHAPTER II

## Constitution, Powers and Functions of the Assam Board of Revenue

Constitution 3. (1) The State Government shall constitute for of the Board. the State of Assam a Board to be known as the Assam Board of Revenue.

Membership (2) The Board shall consist of three members of the Board, to be appointed by the State Government. Quali fica-(3) A member of the Board shall either be a pertion of the son who, in the opinion of the State Government, is, member. by reason of his wide administrative o. judicial experience, fitted to serve on the Board or a person who is qualified to be appointed as a Judge of a High Court.

(4) The State Government shall appoint one of the Chairman of the Board. members of the Board to Act as the Chairman thereof.

(5) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-Constitution of Benches. section (2), the Chairman of the Board shall be competent to constitute or reconstitute Benches consisting of one or two members of the Board to dispose of any case or class of cases and the decisions of such Benches shall be deemed to be the decisions of the Board.

(6) If there be any difference of opinion between Decision where a p- the members constituting a two-member Bench in peal heard disposing of a case, the matter shall be placed before by two the Chairman who may, in his discretion, either refer members. the matter to the third member or refer it to the full Board for hearing and finally disposing of the matter.

(7) No person shall be retained as a member of the Board after he has attained the age of sixty years.

(8) The salary and allowances of the members of the Board shall be such as may be prescribed.

Power of 5. Without prejudice to anything contained in State Section 4, the State Government may, by notification, Government assign to the Board such other duties and functions to assign additional as it may deem fit.

Board's deci-6. No appeal or revision shall lie against any order sion final. passed by the Board in the exercise of its powers of appeal or revision under this Act.

Board's po-7. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in or its own Section 6 to the contrary, and subject to Section 8, the Board may, on the application of any of the parjudgment.

Provided that no such decision or order shall be reviewed unless notice has been given to the opposite parties to appear and to show cause why such order interimeters or decision should not be reviewed. based and lo (2) An application for review under sub-section (1) by any party shall be made within ninety days from the date of the decision or order of the Board.

(3) In computing the period of limitation, the provisions of the Indian Limitation Act, 1908 applicable to the applications for review of a judgment or Act IX of order of a Civil Court shall, so far as may be, apply to applications for review under this section.

Amendment 8. Clerical or arithmetical mistakes in decision or of decision orders or errors arising therein from any accidental or orders. slip or omission may at any time be corrected by the Board either of its own motion or on the application of any of the parties.

Losts

9. In any proceeding referred to in Section 4 or Section 7, the Board may award such costs as it thinks fit and determine by whom such costs are to be paid and, where there are several persons liable, the amount to be paid by each such person. Any cost awarded by the Board shall be recoverable as if it were an arrear of land revenue.

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10. Subject to the orders of the State Government, the Board may hold its Court at any place within the State of Assam.

Contempt 11. The Board shall have the same powers of dealing with contempt of the Board or in respect of any proceedings before the Board as if the Board were a High Court referred to in Article 214 of the Constitution of India.

#### CHAPTER III

#### MISCELLANEOUS

Power to n ke rules. 12. (1) The State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules consistent with the provisions of this Act, for carrying out the purposes of this Act save in regard to the matters specified in Section 13.

> (2) All rules under this section shall be laid for not less than fourteen days before the Assam Legislative Assembly as soon as possible after they are made and shall be subject to such modifications as the Legislative Assembly may make during the session in which they are so laid or the session immediately following.

Power to make Regulation by the Board.

13. (1) Subject to the previous sanction of the State Government the Board shall, from time to time, frame regulations consistent with the provisions of this Act and rules made under Section 12 for regulating its procedure and disposal of its business.

(2) The regulations made under sub-section (1) shall be published in the Official Gazette.

Repeal and Saving.

Assam Act VIII of 14. (1) The Assam Board of Revenue Act, 1959, is hereby repealed. 1960.

(2) The enactments specified in the third column of Schedule 'B' are hereby repealed or amended to the extent mentioned in the fourth column thereof.

(3) Notwithstanding such repeal under sub-sections (1) and (2), any decision taken, order made, anything done or any proceeding commenced under any of the provisions of the Act repealed shall, in so far as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, continue in force and shall be deemed to have been taken, made, done or commenced under the corresponding provisions of this Act.
